Class 1: SSADL HOME PRODUCED MEMBERS CHALLENGE

QUALIFIERS 2021 - Comprising of SSADL/Spillers Members Open Challenge. SSADL Members Mountain & Moorland Challenge and SSADL Members Lead Rein/ First Ridden Challenge. *

This class will be divided into 3 sections:

- a) Horse or pony aged 15-18 years old
- b) Horse or pony aged 19 – 23 years old
- c) Horse or pony aged 24 years old and over



Class 2: In hand Young Stock.

Weaning, yearling, 2&3 years olds.

Class 3: Mountain & Moorland Small Breeds

Open to mountain & moorland ponies registered with their respective breed societies. Stallion, mare, colt, Filly, gelding, any age.

Class 4: Mountain & Moorland Large Breeds

Open to mountain & moorland ponies registered with their respective breed societies. Stallion, mare, colt, filly, gelding, any age.

Class 5: Part Bred & Non-registered.

Open to part or non-registered. Stallion, mare, colt, filly, gelding, any age.

Class 6: Miniature / Shetland Ponies

Open to Miniature and Shetland ponies: registered and non-registered.
Stallion, mare, colt, filly, gelding, any age.

Class 7: Novice Horse / Pony

Open to all ponies and horses that have not been placed 1st in any in hand show.

Class 8: Rare & Foreign Breeds

Stallion, mare, colt, filly, gelding, any age.

Class 9: Cob / Cob Type

Stallion, mare, colt, filly, gelding, any age.

Class 10: Coloured

Stallion, mare, colt, filly, gelding, any age.

Class 11: Ex Racehorses & Rescue

Open to all horses and ponies that are retrained racehorses or any mare, stallion, colt, filly, gelding, any age that has been rescued by a recognised charity.

RIDDEN

Class 12: Lead Rein

Ponies not exceeding 128cm. Rider must not have attained their 8th birthday before 1st January 2020. Pony must be ridden in a snaffle bridle with lead rein attached to the noseband. Pony must be 4 years and over

Class 13: First Ridden

Ponies not exceeding 128cm. Rider must not have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January 2020. Pony must be ridden in a snaffle bridle. Pony must be 4 years and over

Class 14: Ridden Mountain & Moorland Small Breeds

Open to mountain & moorland ponies registered with their respective breed societies. Pony must be 4 years and over.

Class 15: Ridden Mountain & Moorland Large Breeds.

Open to mountain & moorland ponies registered with their respective societies breed. Pony must be 4 years and over.

Class 16: SSADL HOME PRODUCED MEMBERS CHALLENGE

QUALIFIERS 2021 - Comprising of SSADL/Spillers Members Open Challenge. SSADL Members Mountain & Moorland Challenge and SSADL Members Lead Rein/ First Ridden Challenge.

*This class will be divided into 3 sections:

- a) Horse or pony aged 15-18 years old
- b) Horse or pony aged 19-23 years old
- c) Horse or pony aged 24 years old and over



Class 17: Ridden Rare & Foreign Breeds

Stallion, mare, gelding- 4 years & over.

Class 18: Ridden Cob / Cob Type

Stallion, mare, gelding- 4 years & over.

Class 19: Ridden Coloured

Stallion, mare, gelding- 4 years & over.

Class 20: Hacks & Hunters

Stallion, mare, gelding- 4 years & over. 14.2hh and over.

Class 21: Novice Horse / Pony

Open to all ponies and horses that have not been placed 1st in any show.
Stallion, mare, gelding- 4 years & over. Walk and trot only in the going round.

Class 22: Show Hunter Ponies & Show ponies

Stallion, mare, gelding- 4 years & over. Under 14.2hh.

Class 23: Novice Rider

Open to all novice riders not to been placed 1st in any show. Stallion, mare, gelding- 4 years & over. Walk and trot only in the going round.

Class 24: Ridden Ex Racehorses & Rescue

Open to all horses and ponies that are retrained racehorses or that have been rescued by a recognised charity. Stallion, mare, gelding- 4 years & over.

Class 25: Ridden Concours

Stallion, mare, gelding- 4 years & over.

*** SSADL Home Produced Members Qualifiers are OPEN to both Members and Non-Members of SSADL No Spurs, No Galloping, No Wearing of Face/Body Jewellery. Foals are NOT permitted SSADL Classes For In-Hand Classes- Minimum age of handler = 11 years old. First Ridden ponies/riders will be asked after the initial walk round to come into the centre of the ring. First Ridden Competitors will only canter in their individual shows. Lead Rein Riders: If a strip section is required a lead rein rider MUST stay mounted. STALLIONS- Either for In Hand or Ridden classes, Competitors Must be 16 years of age or over. Competitors cannot enter the ring once the command of trot has been given. The same rider/handler/pony/horse combination must stay the same from qualifier to grand final. ALL COMPETITORS SHOULD AQUAINT THEMSELVES WITH SSADL RULES BEFORE ENTERING**

Qualification Cards: The 1st to 2nd from each AGE section will qualify for the above Open Members challenge. (If a competitor has already qualified the qualification card can be passed down no lower the 5th place). The two highest placed Mountain and Moorland ponies within a class will receive the Mountain and Moorland Challenge Qualification Cards. The two highest placed Lead Rein/First Ridden ponies within a class will receive the Lead Rein/First Ridden Challenge Qualification Cards.

All qualification cards MUST be returned to SSADL Head Office within the 10 day period of date of show . Qualification cards MUST be correctly and fully completed. Please follow the instructions listed on the qualification card. Once a qualification card is sent in and is correct only then will Members be eligible for the Members Challenge Finals to be held at the SSADL National Championship Show on the 11th and 12th September 2021 at Onley Grounds, Rugby, Warwickshire.

• A COMPETITOR MAY ONLY ACCEPT ONE QUALIFICATION CARD PER CHALLENGE. IN-HAND AND RIDDEN PONIES MEMBERS CHALLENGE

The Members Challenge -In – Hand qualifiers will be divided into 2 sections:

1. Open- Open to all types/breeds of Senior Ponies and Horses, From all walks of the Equestrian sectors.
2. Mountain and Moorland – Open to Native Mountain and Moorland Breeds

The Members Challenge -Ridden qualifiers will be divided into 3 sections:

1. Open – Open to all types/breeds of senior ponies and horses, from all walks of the equestrian sectors.
2. Lead Rein/First Ridden Ponies – Mountain and Moorland and Plaited ponies to compete together.
3. Mountain and Moorland Ponies - Open to Native Mountain and Moorland Breeds .
